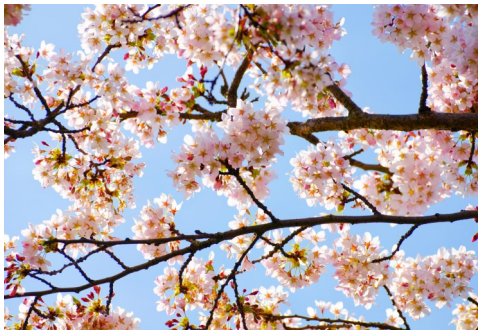
If adopted, this new Policy 604.1 will replace the following existing policies:

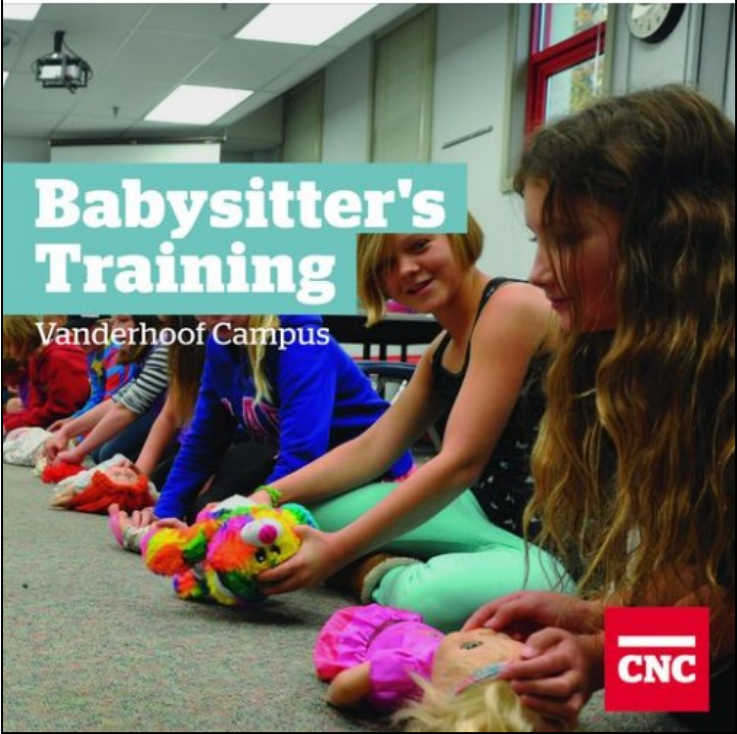
Free Course
