Speaking of forms...Did you know that our school district is required to have a copy of your child's birth certificate and a copy of either your child's Care Card or BC Services Card? Over the year, Mrs. Vossen will be checking your student's file to see if either of those copies are missing. If you receive a note from the school about missing documentation, please bring the originals in as soon as possible. If you know you haven't presented an original birth certificate or BC Services Card to the school when registering your child, please bring them by, and we will photocopy them for your student's file.
