Good news! We are scheduled to have three visits from a District Numeracy teacher, Ms. Roberta Toth. She will be at our school on November 3, 10 and 17 during which time she will be working with staff and students from various grade levels. In some classes, she will demonstrate a math SNAP lesson and in other classes, she is scheduled to co-mark a math assessment.

Math is no longer a list of rules to be memorized but as a way of looking at the world.

Here is a brief list of some of these changes that have taken place since we were young:

- emphasis on the "why" and the "how" (not just on getting the right answer),
- real-world applications,
- · incorporation of digital math games,
- new terminology chunking, partitioning, mental math strategies, etc.

Every Decker Lake Husky has a username and password for an on-line math program called Mathletics. This program follows the BC curriculum and is very comprehensive. Your child is invited to log in at home to practice and learn essential numeracy skills. For log in information, please contact the school.


