Dear Husky Families,

Unfortunately, DLES will be losing a classroom next school year due to low enrollment. DLES will have four divisions next year instead of the current five (K/1, 2/3, 4/5, 6/7). K-3 learners will stay in the primary end of the school and 4-7 learners will stay in the intermediate end. Our office administration hours will be reduced by an hour a day in the fall and we will be reduced to two noon hour supervisors.


